STUDENT ATHLETIC CONTRACT

Between: _____, student and Sunnybrook Christian Academy.

Participation in athletics is a privilege, not a right. The athlete must earn this privilege through dedication, desire, and discipline. Without the pursuit of those, the athlete can in no way do justice to himself or SCA. The Athlete must discipline himself or herself to be a good citizen and student in order to achieve excellence. The staff of Sunnybrook believes that tradition of winning is established and maintained upon the principles of athletic achievement and character training of the young person. The student is not an athletic student, but a student athlete.

FEES: Fees should be paid in full prior to selected sport season.

ATTENDANCE: All team members of each sport will attend all scheduled practices and meetings. No practice can be missed. If circumstances arise whereby the student cannot attend a practice or meeting, the coach must be notified prior to practice or meeting by personal contact, phone call, or written note from the parent or guardian. Any athlete, who cuts practice, fails to appear for a game, fails to make scheduled meetings, or fails to attend school on game day may not be allowed to suit up for the current game and/or next game, to be determined by the coach and administration. Excessive absence from practices, games, or meeting may be cause for removal from athletics. All Athletes are required to attend class regularly. Athletes delinquent in class attendance and/or class assignments are subject to disciplinary action. Lack of attendance in classes may result in failure of class work, resulting in ineligibility to participate in athletics as dictated in "NO PASS NO PLAY RULES" of the SCA Handbook.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for athletics, the athlete must be in compliance with Sunnybrook Christian Academy policies concerning enrollment. Eligibility for weekly athletic participation shall be determined by grade/incident report. The athlete must be passing all subject to be eligible for any sport competition.

DISCIPLINE: Athletes should be leaders on and off the court/field. Excessive or repeated discipline notices will result in athlete not being able to participate in practice(s), scrimmage(s), tournament(s), and/or game(s).

GRADES: Athletes should maintain a 75 "C" or better in each class. If an athlete has a 74 "D" or lower, he/she will be allowed to miss practice in order to attend tutoring. Per the "NO PASS / NO PLAY guidelines", the athlete will have 5 days (Saturday – Wednesday) to have the opportunity to raise his/her grade for that class. Failing list reports will be submitted end of day Thursday. Weekly grade check every Friday to determine if athlete will be on failing list report. If not passing after 1st week ; athlete will not be permitted to participate in practice and/or games for 2 weeks. Athlete will only be allowed to return to practice and/or participate in competition with an Athlete Participant Form signed from the principal and submitted to the respective coach.

SPORTS CHANGES: It is recommended that all athletes participate in as many sports as they are capable. Once an athlete begins the in-season training period of a sport, he/she should not quit while that sport is in season. The student athlete is to exemplify the highest regard of leadership and commitment not only for themselves but also to their team. It shall be the prerogative of the coach of the in-season sport to release the athlete to another sport. No athlete may participate in a second sport until the athlete has been cleared from the first sport by obtaining a written release. The athletic fee paid for the sport that is dropped is non-refundable and non-transferable.

GAME DAY: Players must ride to games as a team. Parents may pick up their athlete from the game. Players will only be allowed to leave the school or game with their parents, unless other arrangements have been made with the coaching staff. Permission to ride with other parents must be submitted to coaches in writing prior to the game.
