



## SCA Elementary Youth Sports

### Parent Code of Conduct

As a SCA PARENT/GUARDIAN, I WILL:

- Be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, other players, all coaches, officials and spectators at every game or practice .
- Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using inappropriate language or gestures.
- Remain in the spectator area during games. Let the coach do their job or join the coaching team.
- Refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices.
- Respect the officials and their authority during games.
- Never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the games, or just before or after practice(s), and will take time to speak with the coaches at an agreed time and place.
- Show my support for the entire team and not just my child.
- Never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake.
- Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance. We are here to teach our children the basic fundamentals of the sport and to have a Christ-like attitude on and off the court or playing field.
- Inform the coach of any conflicts with practices and tournaments well in advance of the event, so that the coach can adequately prepare, make adjustments, etc.
- Inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child, in advance.
- Learn the rules of the game your child is playing.
- Follow all the rules of host sites, practice areas, such as no food, no coolers and to please throw away trash in proper receptacles, etc.
- Ensure that relatives and guests abide the previous stated rules as well.
- Be mindful that coaches, players, parents and volunteers are all representative of Sunnybrook Christian Academy.
- Agree that if I fail to abide by the Parent Code of Conduct, SCA guidelines, CALSA rules and Host site rules, I am subject to disciplinary action that could include, but not limited to the following:
  - Verbal warning by official, head coach, tournament director, and/or SCA Administration.
  - Written warning and/or reprimand.
  - Parental game/match/tournament suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by SCA Administration.
